

READINGS: Isaiah 63:16-17; 64:1,3-8 , 1 Corinthians 1:3-9

GOSPEL: Mark 13:33-37

LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT CANDLE



Priest: Lord God, let your blessing come upon us as we light the candles of this wreath.
May the wreath and its light be a sign of Christ's promise to bring us salvation.
May he come quickly and not delay.
We ask this through Christ, our Lord.

All: **Amen.**

Priest: Lord, our God, we praise you for your Son, Jesus Christ; He is Emmanuel, the hope of the peoples.

All: **Prepare the way of the Lord.
We light this candle in hope,
The hope of our coming saviour, Jesus.
Let us prepare then, the way of the Lord.**

JESSE TREE SYMBOLS

Through the season of Advent, we will add two symbols each week to the Jesse Tree. They remind us of the faithfulness of God and of the men and women God used to prepare the world, down through Jewish history for the coming of Jesus.

 The **Star** is a symbol of the wonder of God's creation (Genesis 1:14-19). Stars were also often symbols of God's future promises to people like Abraham (Genesis 22:15-18) and Balaam (Numbers 24:15-19). The star announces the fulfilment of God's ultimate promise - Jesus' birth, God with us (Matthew 2:1-12).

Noah's Ark reminds us of Noah trusting God's promise and of the never ending covenant of love God made with his people (Genesis 6:1-8:22). 

The first Sunday of Advent marks the beginning of the new liturgical year. This new liturgical cycle is referred to as Year B and features the gospel of Mark.

The two great feasts of Christianity - the Nativity and Easter—are each preceded by a period of preparation: Advent and Lent. The emphasis of these seasons is on the mental and spiritual preparation to fully enter into the great mysteries of faith. In the Nativity, we celebrate God become human; God present in the world in a physical way. Advent is a time to remember the many varied ways that God continues to be present in the world.

By the time the Church begins to celebrate Advent as a period of preparation towards Christmas, the stores have been filling with Christmas paraphernalia for weeks. It starts out small with a few decorations and wrapping paper and eventually takes over every retail outlet. In the midst of this excess of Christmas consumerism, it is often difficult to draw attention to the season of Advent and the need to prepare spiritually for the celebration of Christmas. It is important to stay awake, as we are cautioned in this week's gospel. Awake to what is happening around us in the world and awake to what is happening within us.

[Christian Initiation of Children of Catechetical Age]

Registrations are open for children aged 7 years or older who wish to receive the Sacraments in 2021. There are four steps:

- Step 1:** Contact the Parish Sacramental Registrar, Hazel, on **3849 7158** or **sec. umg@bne.catholic.net.au** and **register** your child who will receive a Mass card.
- Step 2:** Come along to Mass as often as possible to enable your child to learn the ropes, feel confident in the church, **participate in the liturgy** as he/she is ready and begins to feel at home.
- Step 3:** As Fr Pat gets to know you and your child he will **invite** you to take the next step.
- Step 4:** Children are **enrolled** in the Sacrament Program and will attend family centred activity sessions to **prepare** for the celebration of **Penance, Confirmation and First Communion.**
