I am from a big family. I am the 6th of nine children of my lovely parents, Chacko and Rosamma. I carry the strong faith of my parents as the cornerstone of my own spiritual life. I joined the Missionary Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament (MCBS) in 2003 at the age of 16, and after 12 years of formation I was ordained a priest on January 3, 2015. My first appointment was in the Communication Office of our Order in Kochi, Kerala.

In 2020, January 13, I came to the Archdiocese of Brisbane and was appointed associate pastor in Jubilee Catholic Parish. From January 8, 2022 to January 13, 2025 I served as the Parish Priest of Star of the Sea Catholic Parish, Cleveland.

Beyond my pastoral work, I enjoy listening to music, following sports, and love bottle art. I look forward to getting to know all of you better and to supporting you in your faith journey. I am excited and eager to walk with you in faith, to listen to your stories, and to share in the mission of our Church.

Please know that I am here to serve you, and I ask for your prayers as we embark on this journey together. May God bless every one of you, and may our time together be fruitful in His grace.

I am originally from India, but also lived in New Zealand, before my family immigrated to Brisbane nearly two decades ago.

After high school I briefly studied engineering at QUT during which time I began discerning a vocation to the priesthood. I spent a year formally discerning at *Canali House* (as it was known then). I also briefly studied Arts at UQ before entering the seminary in 2015. I was ordained a deacon in 2020 and served at Gatton-Laidley Parish. I was then ordained a priest in 2021 within two hours of a COVID lockdown! Since then I have ministered at the Cathedral and then at Caloundra before landing here last Sunday. I have gone from country, to city, to coast, to now inner-city, so I welcome to experience and have no doubt that I will enjoy my time here.

I have a wide range of interests and am curious about most things. I love the Church's theology, spirituality and liturgy and hope to share that love with you all during my time here.

I also enjoy discovering "foodie" places so I welcome your suggestions on places worth visiting – and if you wish to join then all the better! Beyond food, if there are points of interest around the parish, I welcome your recommendations.

If any of you do enjoy wood-working, please let me know as I have a project or two in mind.

My top priority at present is to get familiar with as many of you as possible. To this end, I will bring a diary with me to masses and jot down your name and contact if you would like to meet up, host me, or be hosted over the coming months.

## PARISH SACRAMENTAL JOURNEY: CICCA

### [Christian Initiation of Children of Catechetical Age]

Registrations are open for children aged 7 years or older who wish to receive the Sacraments in Round 1 2025. There are four steps:

**Step 1:** Contact the Parish Office on **3849 7158** or email **sec.umg@bne.catholic.net.au** and **register** your child who will receive a Mass card.

**Step 2:** Come along to Mass as often as possible to enable your child to feel confident in the church, **participate in the liturgy** and to feel at home.

**Step 3:** As the Priests get to know you and your child you will be **invited** to take the next step. Please note we usually run two groups per year.

**Step 4:** Children are **enrolled** in the Sacrament Program and will attend family centred activity sessions to **prepare** for the celebration of **Penance, Confirmation and First Communion**.
