Friends,

Last weekend we heard the gospel preached on Jesus' calling of his first disciples. Peter a fisherman is in awe of Jesus and so leaves everything – his world essentially – and follows Jesus into a ministry of drawing people *up* into the Church – the “boat” – so that they may be close to Jesus Christ. In this regard the Church at worship on its knees on Sunday is not too dissimilar to Peter on his knees before Jesus in the boat.

Both Fr. Rony and I raised the point that the parish's vitality and its *life* as disciples with Peter involve the ministry of drawing people to Christ. I highlighted as examples the very visible ministries we see within mass – the ministries of altar server, reader, sacristan, etc. which, when done well leads people into the mysteries in our Word and Sacrament.

You and I are members of the Church because others have brought us – not only to the church buildings and services – but into the Catholic family. This is not an automatic process and the absence of some of our children and grandchildren makes this evident. That bringing in happens in various ways – sometimes in positive experiences of the parish's communal life, other times in mystic moments of prayer and worship, other times in the hands on work we do in reaching out to people on the margins. Which of these areas do you find life in?

At the risk of our words merely staying abstract ideas, we have provided a survey below (see QR Code) by which you can express your interest in sharing in the Church's work – in Peter's work. I would stress that this is a chance to lean into your gifts and interests, which you find life-giving. If it is life-giving for you, it will be life-giving for the rest of us.

I look forward to seeing what you have to say!

Bookings with Ros on Ph. 3349 9218. Menu selection available. Dessert is an alternate drop.

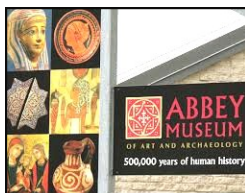
The Raffle will be drawn after lunch and self-service tea and coffee.

## PARISH SACRAMENTAL JOURNEY: CICCA

### [Christian Initiation of Children of Catechetical Age]

Registrations are open for children aged 7 years or older who wish to receive the Sacraments in Round 1 2025. There are four steps:

- Step 1:** Contact the Parish Office on **3849 7158** or email **sec.umg@bne.catholic.net.au** and register your child who will receive a Mass card.
- Step 2:** Come along to Mass as often as possible to enable your child to feel confident in the church, **participate in the liturgy** and to feel at home.
- Step 3:** As the Priests get to know you and your child you will be **invited** to take the next step. Please note we usually run two groups per year.
- Step 4:** Children are **enrolled** in the Sacrament Program and will attend family centred activity sessions to **prepare** for the celebration of **Penance, Confirmation and First Communion**.
