## FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT YEAR C

29 / 30 March 2025

**READINGS: Joshua 5:9-12, 2 Corinthians 5:17-21**

**GOSPEL: Luke 15:1-3, 11-32**

I suspect the parable of the prodigal son stands among the more memorable of Jesus' parables, simply on account of the automatic feeling of injustice it stirs in the hearer. Not a few of us may even identify with the older son – his keeping the rules and thus feeling that, compared with his brother, his father did not display appreciation for him. It remains for the homilies this weekend to tease the dynamics and justices and injustices at play.

I wish to note here however, the culture which the father displays in this parable – one of respecting his son's freedom and one of celebrating his return – whatever his motivations - with exuberance. God's respecting of our freedom and God's accepting of our return – whatever our motivations – is an unambiguous message across the scriptures. In imitating God, the Church too respects the freedom of people to stay or leave the fold and celebrates those who join or return down the line.

It is from this standpoint then that we expend our gifts and our talents – I commend the 23 parishioners who did respond to the call for volunteers earlier this year. It is partially also from this standpoint that the church spends from its resources to keep its churches and facilities dignified and beautiful. Having made a fitting place in which God comes among us, the church hopes we also may experience the joy with which God receives us in a beautiful setting. We would rightly be confused if someone threw us a party, and used shabby or aging materials and decorations.

Churches have been decorated in various ways – sometimes we treat our art too as decoration. While some art *can* have some overlap with decoration, it has clear functions and this was the focus of my masters thesis in seminary. I recently presented a summary of the thesis to our young adults and have been told there is some interest among the rest of to hear the presentation too. If you are interested please express your interest via the QR code below. I plan to present it on the 8<sup>th</sup> May at 4pm in the St. Bernard's community centre.

All of our effort as a church is in some ways a celebration put on for those who wish to engage (and at times re-engage) with faith – our programs, our sacraments, social events. I commend you all in what you contribute to this end. I also welcome those who are feeling inspired to share more of their talents with the parish.

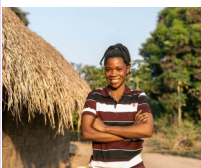
