### GOSPEL

**Luke 4:1-13** *Filled with the Holy Spirit, Jesus was led by the Spirit through the wilderness where he was tempted.*

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we enter the holy season of Lent, I extend a warm welcome to each of you, and invite you to journey with us as a parish family in these forty days of reflection, penance, and prayer. The first Sunday of Lent calls us to examine our hearts and minds, to reflect on the temptations we face, and to look to the example of Jesus who was led into the wilderness to be tested.

In the Gospel today, we read of Jesus' time in the desert, where He fasted and prayed for forty days. It was a time of deep personal challenge and spiritual growth. Jesus faced the temptations of the devil, yet He overcame them through trust in God's Word and through prayer. This story serves as a powerful reminder for us that Lent is not merely about giving something up, but about preparing our hearts to receive more of God's love and grace.

This is a season for spiritual renewal, a time to strengthen our relationship with God through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Just as Jesus withdrew into the desert to seek His Father's will, we are called to step away from the distractions of everyday life and seek the presence of God more intentionally.

I encourage each of you to embrace this time with a spirit of humility and openness. Allow this Lenten season to be a time to grow in your faith, to reflect on areas of your life that need healing, and to renew your commitment to following Christ more faithfully.

The word "Lent" comes from an old English word that means "springtime," so it reminds us of spring cleaning and the new life in nature during spring. This season of Lent is a time of special grace for us in which we want to do some spring cleaning in our lives and enjoy new life as a result. I wish you all a great time and may this Lent renew us to a new person.

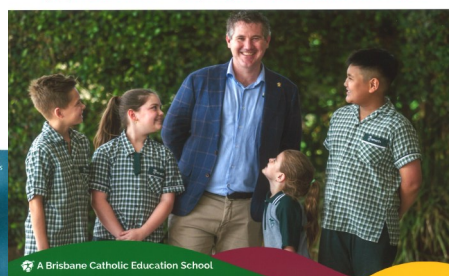
