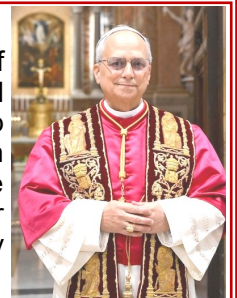

LEO XIV IS THE NEW POPE

"Peace be with all of you!" - the first words of Pope Leo XIV. The Conclave has elected 69 year old Cardinal Robert Francis Prevost as the 267th Bishop of Rome. Leo is the first pope to have been born in the United States. He is also a citizen of Peru, where he has spent much of his life. He was elected leader of the world's 1.4 billion Catholics on the second day of the conclave.



Our Double Celebration

Friends, this weekend - for the worse - and for the better, carries two foci: Mother's Day and the World Day of Prayer for Vocations. For the worse because, I imagine the shared space will result in one or the other getting less attention. For the better because in some strange way, they stand closer together than at first glance.

Motherhood (and parenthood broadly), Priesthood and religious life couldn't seem further apart in the types of demands they make and what each are celebrated for. All three however, are avenues by which a Christian trains to shift their focus away from themselves and onto others in their care. It is an imitation of God who out of God's freedom not only creates us, but exhibits a spirit of charity and love for us. Thus, these different vocations within the Christian life are all pathways to holiness. The call to holiness is not limited only to priests and religious – it is to all Christians.

If we are tempted to imagine the saints (from *sanctus* meaning "holy [ones]") as the canonised priests and religious from our past, let us remember that the two greatest saints in our Church are Mary and Joseph. The silence about their lives in scripture, says something to us about God's blessing of the everyday and ordinary of family life – the turning up daily, the stretched patience, the rituals of love, the chores, the hopes and prayers for the future and so on. For this reason, priesthood and religious life will always exist *for* the service of family life – have you noticed that the priest never in mass says "I"? All prayers are said on behalf of the Church, the "We". For your sake then, as you pray for your mothers today, I ask that you say a prayer for young men and women to answer the call to be labourers in God's harvest.

On behalf of Fr. Rony and myself, I wish our mothers, Happy Mother's Day!

ST CATHERINE'S SENIORS COACH TRIP

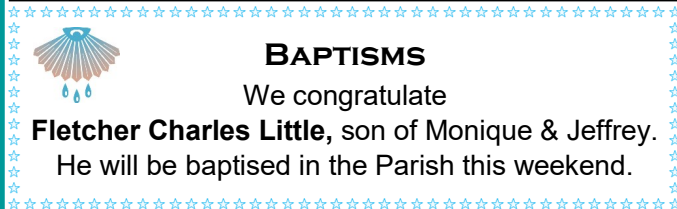
**Wednesday 28 May - Coach departs
