## STS PETER AND PAUL, APOSTLES YEAR C

28 / 29 June 2025

### READINGS

**Acts 12:1-11**

*Now I know it is indeed true: the Lord has saved me from the power of Herod.*

**2 Timothy 4:6-8, 17-18**

*All that remains now is the crown of righteousness.*

### GOSPEL

**Matthew 16:13-19**

*You are Peter, and I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven.*

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today we celebrate the great Feast of **Saints Peter and Paul**—two pillars of the early Church, two very different men, united by their faith in Jesus Christ and their mission to spread the Gospel.

Peter, the fisherman, was bold, passionate, and often impulsive. He was the first to confess Jesus as the Messiah, yet also the one who denied Him three times. Still, Jesus chose him to be the **rock** upon which He would build His Church. Peter reminds us that God uses imperfect people to do great things. His leadership, love, and eventual martyrdom in Rome became a foundation for the Church that still stands today.

Paul, once Saul the persecutor, had a dramatic conversion on the road to Damascus. From an enemy of Christ to His greatest missionary, Paul travelled far and wide, preaching the Gospel to the Gentiles. His letters continue to teach and inspire us today. Paul reminds us that no one is beyond God's grace, and that our past does not define our future in Christ.

Though Peter and Paul were different in personality and background, they were united in purpose—to proclaim Jesus crucified and risen, and to give their lives for Him. Both were martyred in Rome, witnesses to the truth they believed.

As we honour these two great saints, let us reflect: Are we bold like Peter in our faith, even after we fall? Are we open like Paul to God's call, even when it leads us beyond our comfort zone?

May Saints Peter and Paul inspire us to love Christ deeply, serve Him faithfully, and proclaim His name with courage.

## PETER'S PENCE COLLECTION THIS WEEKEND 28 / 29 JUNE

*Each year parishes in the Archdiocese of Brisbane and around the world take up the **Peter's Pence** collection on the feast of **Sts Peter and Paul**.*

*The collection is used to support the Holy See's activities and its apostolic mission.*

*It enables the Holy Father to respond to requests for emergency aid and to support projects of direct assistance to those most in need.*

*The collection will be taken up as a **retiring collection (as we exit the church)** at all Masses this weekend.*

## CATHOLIC FORMATION COURSE - MODULE 2

The next module for the Archdiocesan Centre for Catholic Formation will begin in August on Monday nights for 10 weeks. *Understanding, Praying and Living the Scriptures* aims to look at the Scriptures, how they came to be and their interpretation within the Catholic tradition, as well as experience listening to the voice of God in the Scriptures.

There are two options available – onsite at Banyo or (if we can get at least 5 people interested) a livestream hub at our Parish. The sessions are roughly two hours. The 10 sessions cost \$250 per person or \$150 per person for a group of five or more (this would be the cost if we get a hub together). 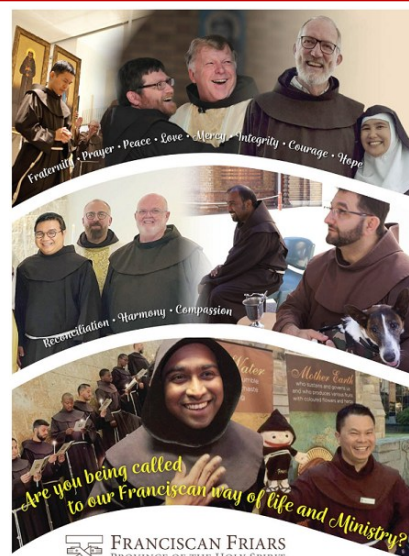
