

St Bernard of**Clairvaux**

(1090–1153) was a French monk, abbot, mystic, theologian, and Doctor of the Church who played a vital role in shaping the Church during the 12th century.

Known for his powerful preaching and deep love for God, he advised Popes, preached the Second Crusade, defended the faith, healed divisions within the Church, and reformed monastic life.

In 1111, at just 20 years old, Bernard entered the monastery at Citeaux, dedicating his life to God. His passion for Christ was so inspiring that his brothers, uncles, and many friends followed him. Under his leadership, a struggling monastic community was revived, leading to the founding of a new monastery in the valley of Wormwoods - later renamed Clairvaux, meaning "valley of light."

His spiritual writings, especially those honouring the Virgin Mary, earned him the title "Mary's Troubadour" - the poet who sings her praises.

St Bernard is the patron saint of beekeepers, bees, and candlemakers, and was gifted with the grace of miracles.

May St Bernard help us deepen our lives in God. We also pray for St Bernard's Primary School and Clairvaux MacKillop College, that our young ones may be inspired by his life and grow in wisdom, faith, and love.
